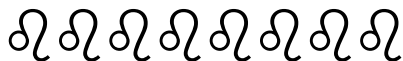

The next Chronicle is the Annual Parish Meeting edition and any Village group or organization is welcome to send in an annual report.

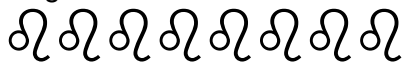

Help tidy up our Village with a Litter Clean Up on **Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> March. Meeting at 10.00am in the Village Hall car park.**

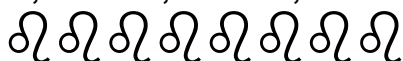
Black sacks will be provided, please bring your own gloves.

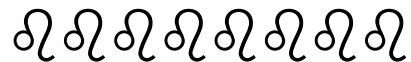

## Chilton Village Ball Saturday 20th March

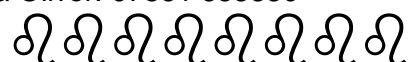

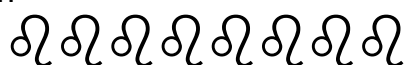

Planning is now under way for the 2010 Abingdon Air & Country Charity Show on **Sunday May 2nd** at Abingdon airfield, Dalton Barracks, Abingdon. This year's show will be the 11th event organised by the all-volunteer committee and will once again support the Thames Valley & Chiltern Air Ambulance Trust.

In this the 70th Anniversary year of the Battle of Britain, we are hoping for a full display from the RAF Battle of Britain Memorial Flight including Spitfire, Hurricane and Lancaster. Dominating the static aircraft park will, hopefully, be another of last year's highlights...the RAF's gigantic C-17 Globemaster III transport from Brize Norton. Overseas aircraft participation is also being sought, to give us a little international flavour and pleasure flights will be available in a 1940s vintage de Havilland Dove airliner.

#### Lights Out

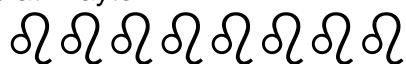
If your street light is out please phone 0800 317802. This is a free phone number, and the light will be repaired. Remember to note the lamp number, which is printed on the lamp post.

#### Old Batteries

Domestic batteries should be placed in a clear bag in your green box. If you do not use a green box they have to be taken to the Recycling Centre at Drayton.

#### Energy Saving Bulbs

Do not place broken energy saving bulbs in the dustbin, they are classed as Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) and should be taken to the Recycling Centre at Drayton
