## The X32

Have you tried the new X32 bus to Oxford via Didcot? If not, I can thoroughly recommend this excellent service. It only takes 45 minutes from Main Street Chilton to Castle Street Oxford, stopping at convenient stops in Didcot before proceeding straight to Oxford.

The bus goes at 10 minutes to every hour between 9.50 am and 2.50 pm. There are two earlier buses and two later, the last bus being 6.48pm. Catch the return bus at the last stop from St. Aldates – H5. Buses return from St. Aldates at 10 minutes to the hour. The last bus leaves Oxford at 5.50pm.

Buses are equipped with a platform which lowers for ease of ascent and descent. This is a very punctual service, so do leave plenty of time to catch it.

Do use this very convenient Monday to Saturday service. Save petrol and parking fees, help save the planet and help save this valuable service for Chilton. By doing so you will also be helping those villagers who do not drive or because of disability or age are unable to access other forms of transport.
