#### Display in All Saints of Chilton Family History

To celebrate the Queen's Jubilee there will be a display between 2.30 and 5pm on Monday 4th June in All Saints' Church of transcriptions of the Chilton Parish Registers:

Baptisms since 1932, Marriages since 1976 and Burials since 1960.

We also hope to display the embroidered panels made for a WI Competition on Family trees.

They show several members of the Butler family in the years, 970, 1170, 1599 and 1763.

We think Mrs Fishenden designed the panels and found the names in the older Parish registers which are now stored mainly in the Berkshire Record office.

I will try to print new plans of the existing graveyard areas for the display and would be pleased to know names and approximate locations for any of your relatives buried in the graveyard without a gravestone, there are a few anonymous mounds I should like to identify.

I am collecting further information for a Jubilee edition of the "*Memorial Inscriptions with some family history, for All Saints' Chilton*". If you have any details of family history about people buried in Chilton since the Queen's Golden Jubilee please can you give it to me for inclusion in this new edition. I am interested in when and where they were born, a brief

history of their careers and if they were not born in Chilton why did they come here to live. Any family trees of older Chilton residents will be very welcome. Kate Crennell
